Directions to Pat and Barb Ward's home:

- Leave Jacksonville by going south on South Main/267 heading to Woodson, IL (4.2 miles)
- Once at Woodson, turn left onto Main Street heading east
- Drive through Woodson
- Continue on Main Street/Woods Frank Road
- After 3.3 miles turn right onto Rawlings Road (first right after you pass the water tower) heading south
- After 1.4 miles turn right onto Taylor Road
- After 0.3 miles turn left onto Happy Hollow heading south
- After 1.6 miles turn left onto Ryan Lane
- Take first driveway on the left and continue all the way up the hill to the parking area.
